## **Membership Qualifications**

Membership is available to those aged 8 and over who have successfully completed one of the Dinghy courses listed below or an equivalent Windsurfing course.

Membership is also available to young people from 8 to 17 years old who are not qualified to join as members in their own right, if a parent or guardian is a member. Such young people may only sail when accompanied within the same boat and in the care of that parent or guardian who is a member.

## **Qualifying Courses**

RYA Level 2 Certificate (or higher), RYA Instructor or Senior Instructor Qualification,

NSSA School Sailing "Gold" Award or RYA Young Sailors Stage 3 Award or RYA Young Sailors Red, White or Blue Racing or Advanced Sailing Award,

or the equivalent to any of the above.

## **Additional Members from the same Household**

Where there is more than one member from the same household, only one member from that household, is required to pay the full annual subscription for membership. All other members from the household would pay an "Additional" Member subscription, currently set at 50%.

The "Full Subscription" member shall be the member whose annual subscription is the most expensive.

When additional members from the same household join the Association, where previously there has only been a single member from that household, the subscription for the additional members shall be the additional amount to bring the total up to what it would have been had all the members paid their appropriate multiple member subscriptions as detailed above.

For example: a Youth Member on his own would pay £70.00 but then if both his parents join, one parent would pay £140.00, the second parent would pay £70.00 and only £35.00 would be required for the original youth member. This totals to £245.00 but the original £70.00 would be credited leaving an extra subscription for the 2 new adult members of £175.00.

## **Concessionary Membership Rates**

NLSA offers concessionary rates to adults who supply proof of eligibility for a Better Inclusive or Concessionary Membership at Hackney leisure centres run by GLL under the following categories:

- For those aged 60 or over: proof of date of birth; Freedom Pass,
- For full-time students in Higher/Further Education (15+ hours): current enrolment letter; NUS card; letter from college or university,
- For those in receipt of Carer's Allowance, Housing Benefit, Income Support, Job Seeker's Allowance, Working Families Tax Credit: current entitlement letter; JSA card; letter from Inland Revenue showing WFTC benefit received (eligibility threshold £16,000 p.a. or less),
- For disabled people: current entitlement letter; Freedom Pass.
